



No One Quite Like Grandma

Items Required for this Project:

- Pink 270mm x 135mm card blank (folded in half)
- Stix2 Seed Bee'd and Fine Glitter - Pink - S57077
- Stix2 pro glue glider
- Stix2 Texture Mounting Sheet - S57130
- Stix2 Ultra Clear Tape - 3mm x 5m - S57089
- Bazzill pink 12" x 12" cardstock
- Bazzill burgundy bling cardstock
- Bazzill white cardstock
- Big Shot die cutting machine
- Sizzlits Hello Kitty Decorative Strip Die - Scallops – 655889
- Sizzix Bigz Die - Flower, Build a Flower #4 – 655975
- Craft knife, cutting mat and ruler
- Peel off greeting (happy birthday)
- Woodware trimmer with Victorian blade cartridge
- General crafting tweezers
- Pink gems
- Printer

Step-by-Step Guide:

1. Print the photograph and greeting onto texture mounting sheet choosing a speciality paper setting or a matte paper setting.
2. Trim all four photographs to 47mm.
3. Stick onto the card starting at 5mm from the top of the card and 5mm from the crease.
4. Stick a peel off greeting at the bottom using tweezers or a craft knife.
5. Dye cut a small white flower, a white decorative strip and a small burgundy bazzill bling flower.
6. Stick the white flower into the centre with a craft dot then add the burgundy flower using a 3D craft dot.
7. Add another craft dot to the top to add interest and place the glitter tube over the top then shake back and forth until fully coated in glitter.
8. Run the pro glue glider over the back of the decorative strip and stick 3mm from the edge of the card.
9. Place gems onto the centre circles one at either side of the greeting to emphasise 'Happy Birthday'.

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10. Add a 3mm strip of adhesive to the border and trim excess from behind with a craft knife.
11. Peel off the protective layer and add glitter.
12. Finally trim the greeting 'Happy Birthday Grandma' using the trimmer and Victorian blade cartridge and stick to the inside of the card.
13. Add glitter. Hold the tube over the clear pads then you won't need a messy tray or sheet of card to pour the excess back into the tube.
14. Rub on the journaling or chosen title with the lolly stick provided.
15. Punch a heart using punch adhesive sheet.
16. Take off the backing sheet and stick onto the t-shirt to bring the page to life. Take off the second layer and press pink foil onto it.
17. Place white card into hearts embossing folder and wind through the Big Shot following the manufacturers instructions to create a heart embossed strip.
18. Trim to the edge of the hearts and stick vertically 15mm from the edge of the page.
19. Add 3D dots to the flower centres and place the tube of micro beads over the top, shake back and forth to cover the dots entirely. TOP TIP: By using these tube glitters and beads its unnecessary to use a messy tray.
20. Cut a piece of Bazzill Burgundy Bling cardstock to cover the large flower on the dye. Also die cut a medium white and blue flower.
21. Attach the white flower to the large burgundy one using a craft dot.
22. Punch a circle from decorative paper and stick onto the top of the flower to embellish the centre.
23. Stick this onto the right hand corner of the page 5mm from the edge and 5mm from the border.
24. Dye cut the tiny flower centre using white card and stick onto the blue flower with a craft dot.
25. Use the eyelet kit to set 2 holes for the ribbon to thread through.
26. Thread ribbon and tie a knot. Trim off any excess leaving about 15mm on each end of ribbon.
27. Stick to her hair to attract attention to the photograph.
28. Finally add gems with tweezers or a craft knife to the page to give it that extra blingy look.
